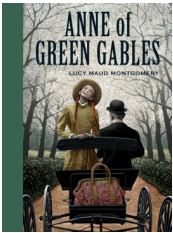


The Life and Legend of Obi-Wan Kenobi

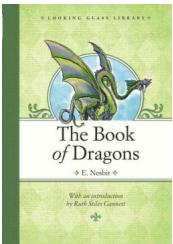


Anne of Green Gables

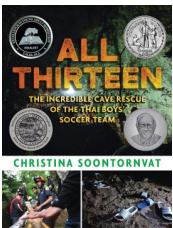


The Book of Dragons

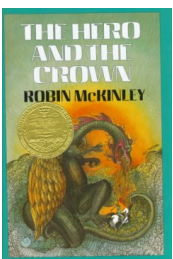

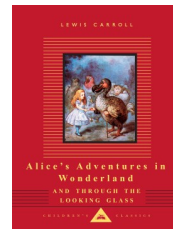


The Once and Future King

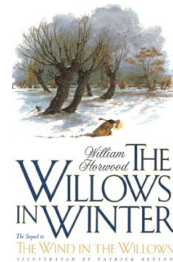


Little Women

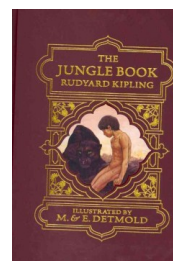


The Willows in Winter
