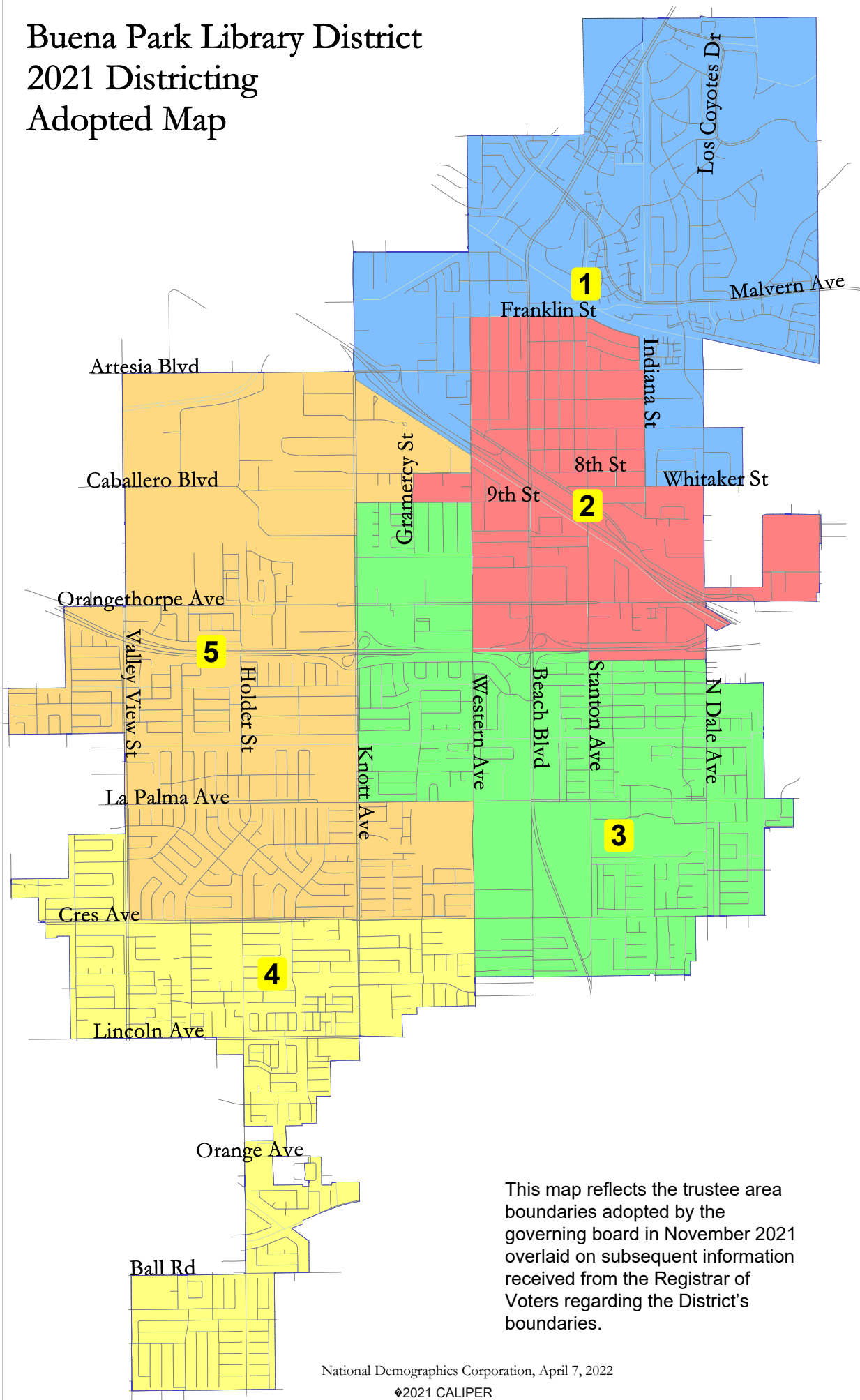


Buena Park Library District 2021 Districting Adopted Map
